

How to remove the *UHealth* network from your computer

Please follow the instructions below on how to remove the *UHealth* network from your computer. These instructions are not exhaustive, and they do not cover all types of configurations.

Windows 8

1. Press the Windows key followed by “R” to open the run menu.
2. Type in ‘ *netsh wlan delete profile name=“UHealth”* ’ (case-sensitive) and press enter.

Windows Vista / Windows 7

1. Click on the Start Menu and then on the Control Panel.
2. Click on “*Network and Internet.*”
3. Under this new window, under the category of Network and Sharing Center, select “*Manage wireless networks.*”
4. Select the *UHealth* network, right-click, and select “*Remove network.*”

Windows XP

1. Click on the Start Menu and then on the Control Panel.
2. Double click on Network Connections.
3. Right-click on your Wireless Network Connection, and select “*Properties.*”
4. Choose the “*Wireless Networks*” tab and select the *UHealth* network in the preferred networks and click on the Remove button.
5. Click “OK” to exit.

MAC OS X

1. Click on the Apple logo on the top left corner of your screen.
2. In the drop down menu click “*System Preferences.*”
3. Under the Internet & Wireless section click on “*Network.*”
4. On the left hand panel select Airport or WiFi.
5. Click on “*Advanced.*”
6. Find the *UHealth* network in the list of Preferred Networks and select it.
7. Click on the “-” sign at the bottom to remove the profile.
8. Click on “OK” and then click on “*Apply*” to apply the changes.

Apple iOS

While on the University of Miami campus:

1. Tap on the Settings icon on your home screen.
2. On the Settings screen, tap on “*WiFi.*”
3. Tap on the arrow next to the *UHealth* SSID on the list.
4. Tap on “*Forget this network*” on top.

Android

1. Tap on the Settings icon located in your Apps.
2. Under the Wireless & Networks, tap on the “*WiFi*” settings and turn it on.
3. Scroll down the list of networks until you find the *UHealth* network. Press and hold the *UHealth* network name, and select “*Forget network.*”

Windows Mobile

1. Tap on the Settings icon.
2. Scroll down until you find the *WiFi*, select it, and turn it on.
3. Click on the “*advanced*” button and look for the *UHealth* network. Press and hold the *UHealth* network name, and select delete.
