Google Chrome

Remove an Add-On/Extension in Google Chrome

- On your computer, open Google Chrome and click on the three vertical dots in the top right corner.
- Navigate to **Extensions** and then **Manage extensions**.
- Browse through your installed extensions and click the **Remove** button next to any extension you wish to uninstall.
- To confirm, select **Remove**.

Microsoft Edge

Remove an Add-On/Extension in Microsoft Edge

- On your computer, open Microsoft Edge and click on the three vertical dots in the top right corner.
- Navigate to **Extensions** and then **Manage extensions**.
- Browse through your installed extensions and click the **Remove** button on any extension you wish to uninstall.
- To confirm, select **Remove**.

Mozilla Firefox

Remove an Add-On/Extension in Mozilla Firefox

- On your computer, open Mozilla Firefox, click the three horizontal lines in the top right corner.
- Click **Add-ons and themes** and select **Extensions**.
- The Add-ons Manager *Manage Your Extensions* page will open in a new tab. Scroll through the list of extensions.
- Click the **ellipsis icon** for the extension you wish to remove and then select **Remove**.
