


Tip Sheet: Enable Distribution Lists and Microsoft 365 Groups to Allow Messages from UM Gmail Accounts

By default, Distribution Lists and Microsoft 365 Groups are set to only people inside the organization. Since Distribution Lists and Microsoft 365 Groups are managed via Microsoft 365 services, they do <u>not</u> recognize Gmail as being "inside" the organization.

To be able to send to a Distribution List from a University of Miami Gmail email address, an <a href="https://owner.com/owner.




Microsoft 365 Group Settings

To be able to send to a Microsoft 365 from a University of Miami Gmail email address, an <u>owner</u> of the group must select "<u>Let people outside the organization email the groups</u>" in the Edit Group > About > External email settings. (See screengrab below.)
